

## Zhangwu

### Project Description

This project is a wind power park outside Fuxin City in the Liaoning region of Northeast China.

China's existing power production is almost exclusively fossil-based, and by increasing the proportion of renewable energy in the grid, this project contributes to carbon emissions reductions of ca 35 000 tons annually.

The wind-power plants are manufactured in Spain and Denmark and therefore constitute technology transfer to China, in keeping with the spirit of the Kyoto Protocol.
